

Prayer Services for the Season of Creation from the Sisters of St. Francis, Clinton, Iowa Week Two: Connected to Creation

Today we invite you to contemplate the Season of Creation and to recognize God in all things. Our prayer will encourage us to reflect on our connections to the rest of creation and how our lives and actions affect those who are voiceless.

Presider: We gather in the name of God, Creator, Redeemer, and Sustainer of the Earth and all creatures! Praise be to the Holy Trinity! God is sound and life, Creator of the Universe, Source of all life, whom the angels sing; wondrous Light of all mysteries known or unknown to humankind, and life that lives in all. (Hildegard of Bingen, 13th Century)

Psalm 19: 1-4, 7-9 New International Version (language adapted)

Side 1: The heavens declare the glory of God;

the skies proclaim the work of God's hands.

Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge.

All: Listen to creation tell of God, listen to God's Word in scripture.

Side 2: They have no speech, they use no words;

no sound is heard from them.

Yet their voice goes out into all the earth,

their words to the ends of the world.
